ORDER OF PROBATION

On January 1, 2008 you were adjudicated delinquent for committing an act of delinquency of DELINQUENT OFFENSE. You have been placed on probation for a period of ONE (1) YEAR, commencing on January 1, 2008. Your terms of probation are as follows:

1. You shall behave well and you shall not violate any laws or ordinances. You shall contact the Probation Officer within twenty-four (24) hours if questioned by law enforcement.
2. You shall obey all rules and orders that your parents give you.
3. You shall let your parents know at all times where you are going, what you are doing, whom you will be with, and when you will be returning home.
4. You shall meet with your Probation Officer at such times and places as set up by your Probation Officer. You shall always be truthful with your Probation Officer and on time for your appointments. It will be your responsibility to contact and speak directly to the Probation Officer to reschedule any missed appointments.
5. You shall attend school each and every day it is in session, as directed by the school system. Otherwise, you shall work at a full-time job, actively attend GED classes, or participate in a home-based school program. If in school, you must maintain a "C" or it's numeric equivalent in all subjects. You must provide the Probation Officer with copies of all progress reports and grade cards within two weeks of receiving said reports.
6. You shall not associate with any person who is currently on probation or parole.
7. You shall follow all orders given to you by the Court or your Probation Officer.
8. You shall not leave the State of Indiana without permission of the Court or your Probation Officer.
9. You shall notify your Probation Officer within twenty-four (24) hours of any change in your address, your employment, or your education.
10. You shall not use, possess, or consume any alcohol or controlled substances without a prescription issued to you by a dentist or doctor; nor shall you be with persons or in places where there is alcohol consumption, and/or using of controlled substances.
11. You shall be in your home at night by 10:00 p.m., except for nights when you are involved in school, employment or religious sanctioned activity, in which case you shall return home immediately after the activity has concluded.
12. You shall pay Court costs to the Clerk of Noble County in the amount of \$160.00 within the period of probation.
13. Pursuant to I.C. 31-40-2-1, you and your parents are jointly liable for the payment to the Probation Office of an Initial Probation Fee of \$50.00, an Administrative Fee of \$100.00 and a probation user's fee of \$15.00 per month for each month of probation.
14. You shall submit to a urinalysis test at the request of any Probation Officer of this Court, any Police Officer acting upon the request of any Probation Officer of this Court, or upon the request or order of this Court. You shall be financially responsible for payment of \$10.00 to the Probation Office for any drug screens ordered.
15. You shall not use or possess any weapons, (i.e. guns, knives, bows, etc.), without prior written permission of the Court or your Probation Officer.

16. You shall waive your right against searches by a Probation Officer, or anyone acting on behalf of the Probation Department, for the purpose of ensuring your compliance with the Order of Probation.
17. You shall write a 1000 word essay explaining why what you did was wrong, how your actions have affected your victim, your family and yourself, and what you will do in the future to avoid such activity. The essay shall be written in pen and is due to the Probation Officer on or before March 1, 2008.

In addition to the above ordered terms, you will also have the following Special Terms (as indicated):

- I.) You shall successfully complete a substance abuse program to be administered by a mental health or addictions treatment provider certified by the State of Indiana to offer said treatment. You shall submit written documentation from said agency to your Probation Officer confirming that you completed all recommended education or treatment.
- II.) You shall forfeit your Driver's License and shall not operate a motor vehicle for a minimum of one (1) YEAR and/or until you successfully complete a substance abuse education or treatment program as directed in Special Term I.
- III.) You shall complete ___ hours of community service work as directed by your Probation Officer.

During the term of probation, if it appears to the Court that you have violated any of the terms of your probation, the Court may, after a hearing, modify your conditions of Probation or revoke probation and commit you to the Indiana Department of Corrections or any other appropriate facility.

I have read the above terms of probation and have discussed any questions I have regarding these terms with a Probation Officer.

My signature indicates that I fully understand all the terms of my probation and I agree to comply with the Order of Probation.
