STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

1. You shall meet with the Noble County Probation Department immediately. You shall report to your probation officer as directed, and you shall truthfully answer all reasonable questions of your officer.
2. You shall obey all laws of the city, county, state and federal government. You shall report any contact with any law enforcement officer to your probation officer within twenty-four (24) hours of such contact.
3. You shall notify your probation officer of any changes in my address, telephone number, employment, or work schedule within twenty-four (24) hours.
4. You shall be employed full-time and support your dependents unless you are given permission by your probation officer or the court not to. If you fail to maintain full-time employment as directed, you shall participate in and successfully complete the Noble County Probation Department's employment program as directed by your probation officer.
5. You shall not possess or use any firearms, destructive device, or other dangerous weapon.
6. You shall waive your right against search and seizure, and permit a Probation Officer or any law enforcement officer acting on your Probation Officer's behalf to search your person, residence, motor vehicle, or any location where your personal property may be found to ensure compliance with probation.
7. You shall remain a resident of _____ County and you shall remain in your state of residence unless you are given permission by your probation officer or the court to leave the state.
8. You shall not use, possess or consume any alcohol, narcotic, drug or controlled substance unless prescribed by a physician or dentist. You shall not enter any bar, tavern or establishment where alcohol is the primary commodity that is served or purchased unless given permission by your probation officer.

9. You shall submit to all drug and alcohol tests at your expense. Two (2) or more dilute specimens could be considered a violation of probation. If you fail a drug test, you may be referred to Noble County Court Services, and you must successfully complete their program, including paying a program fee. You understand that tampering with, carrying in, or altering a urine drug screen while on probation is a crime. If you tamper with, carry in, or alter your urine drug screen, you could be charged with a new offense and your probation could be revoked.
10. You shall not associate with any person of bad character or reputation or with any person who is likely to influence you to commit any crime, or be in the presence of any illegal activity.
11. You understand that should problems arise, or if you do not understand some aspect of probation or what is expected of you, you shall consult with your probation officer or the Court and request assistance or clarification. If you do not ask for help or assistance, you understand that your probation officer and the Court will assume that you are aware of all of your responsibilities under this agreement and that a failure on your part to comply will be dealt with accordingly.
12. You shall under go all DNA testing as provided under I.C. 10-13-6-10.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

1. ____ You shall immediately contact Noble County Court Services, 104 W. Main St., Albion, IN (260) 636-2900 for a substance abuse assessment and you will actively participate in and successfully complete any recommended education and/or treatment program. You shall pay the fee for the program. If treatment is recommended, you understand that you will be referred to an appropriate participating provider and you will be responsible for the costs of that program as well. You will sign any and all releases of information for the agency to forward information to the Probation Department and Noble County Court Services.
2. ____ You shall attend a victim impact panel as directed by your Probation Officer.
3. ____ You understand that your driving privileges are suspended for ____ days.
4. ____ You shall perform ____ hours of community service at a minimum of five (5) hours per week at an agency approved by the community service director.
5. ____ You shall pay restitution as ordered by the court and as directed by your Probation Officer.
6. ____ You shall work faithfully toward obtaining a GED/high school diploma or other vocational training as directed by your Probation Officer.
7. ____ You shall attend English as a New Language Classes as directed by your Probation Officer.
8. ____ You shall pay the sum of \$_____per week on your child support arrearage and you will pay the arrearage of \$_____in full during the term of probation, PLUS the court ordered current child support.
9. ____ You shall complete a period home detention of ____ days/months. You will abide by all rules and pay all fees. The home detention contact number is (260) 636-3327.

10. ____ If you are convicted of a crime, which makes you a “Sex Offender”, you will obey all sex offender terms (see attached).
11. ____ You shall immediately enroll in and successfully complete an anger management course at an approved agency.
12. ____ You agree to pay \$____ for your Public Defender at a rate of \$____ per ____.
13. ____ You shall not initiate contact directly or indirectly with _____.
14. ____ You shall not initiate any unwanted contact directly or indirectly with _____.
15. ____ You shall write a letter of apology to _____ as directed by your Probation Officer.
16. ____ You shall attend and successfully complete the Latino Court Program at the Bowen Center and the “Bienvenido” Acculturation Program. You shall pay all the costs for the programs.
17. ____ You shall attend and successfully complete defensive driving classes at Risk Assessment & Management. You shall pay all of the costs for that program.

During the period of probation, if it appears to the Court that you have violated any one of these conditions of your probation, the Court may, after hearing, modify or enlarge the conditions of your probation or revoke your probation and order the execution of the suspended sentence. A petition to revoke your probation may be filed one (1) year after the termination of probation or forty-five (45) days after the State received notice of the violation.
